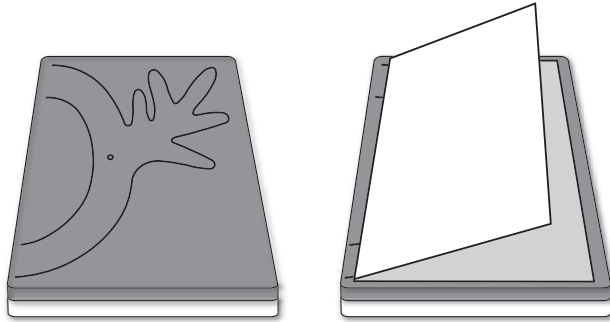

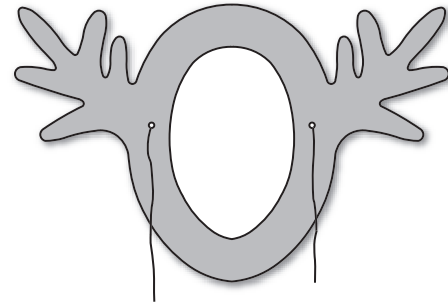

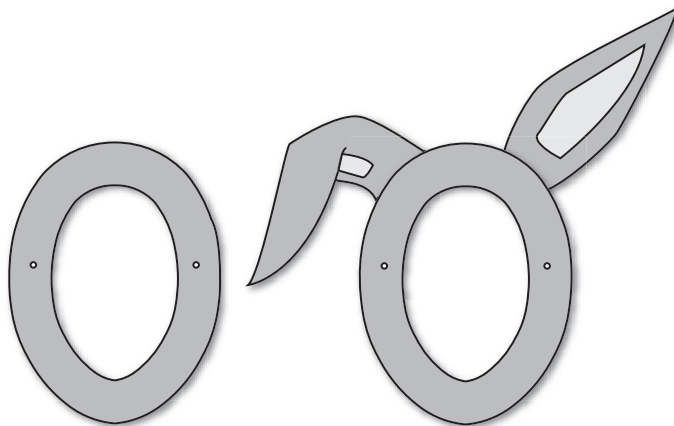

1. Fold a 12" x 18" sheet of cardstock or other paper in half.
2. Place folded paper on the rubber side of Mask die just inside the die blade, then die-cut. The fold will become the middle of the Mask (Figure A).
3. Thread yarn, ribbon, string or Elastic Mask Straps through pre-cut holes to complete the Mask. Make a knot at one end to hold the yarn, ribbon or string in place (Figure B).
4. Combine ears from other Masks to create different looks. Cut off the antlers or ears and glue or staple them onto the oval Mask (Figure C).
5. Figure D shows finished Masks.
