



Bulletin Board, 3-D Christmas Tree

The teacher will die-cut the materials for student use prior to the lesson.

1. Die-cut several sections of the tree from green construction paper.
2. Fold along the middle perforations.
3. Apply double-stick tape along the end flap, overlap the other side over the top and press to seal it shut. It is helpful to slide a metal or wooden ruler inside the folded tube in order to press against the tape for strong adhesion (Figure A).
4. Fasten the flat side of the tubes to the door with a strong adhesive to create a tree design starting at the bottom. If attaching the tree to a bulletin board, simply staple the tubes to the board (Figure B).
5. Add a tree trunk to the base and a dimensional star to the tree top. You can also have students create gift boxes to fasten around the tree trunk (Figure B).
