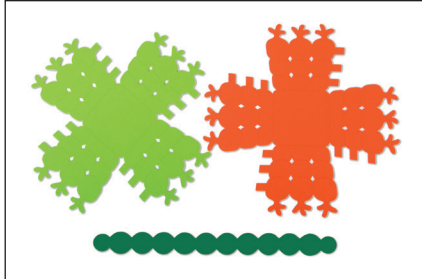

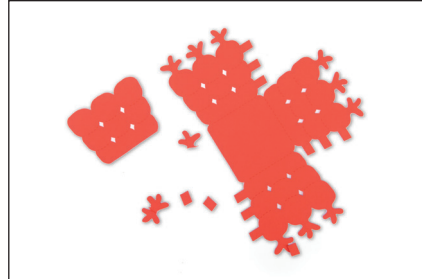

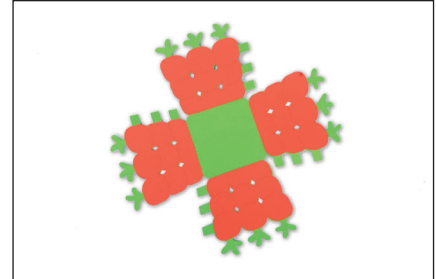

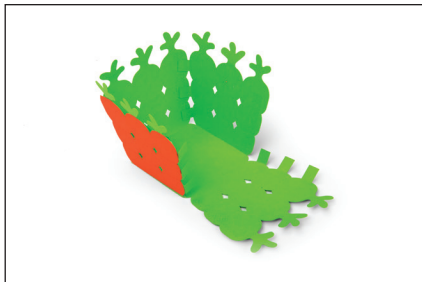

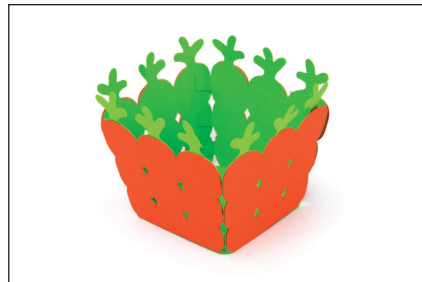

The teacher will die-cut the materials for student use prior to the lesson.

1. Die-cut the basket pieces from colored paper or cardstock (Figure A).
2. Trim away the unwanted pieces (Figure B) to create carrots to layer on top of the basket base (Figure C). You can add extra details with crayons or colored markers (Figure F).
3. Place adhesive on all of the side tabs, fold on the perforations and fasten the four sides together (Figures D & E).
4. Attach the handle on opposite sides of the basket interior to complete the project (Figure F).
5. Fill the basket with treats or other items to coordinate with classroom party themes or units of study.
