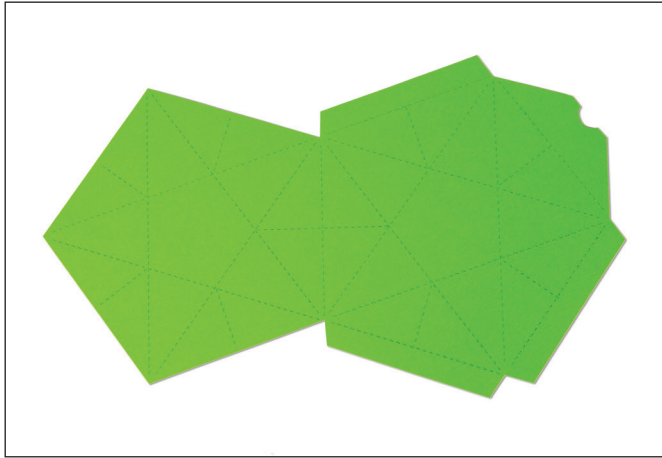

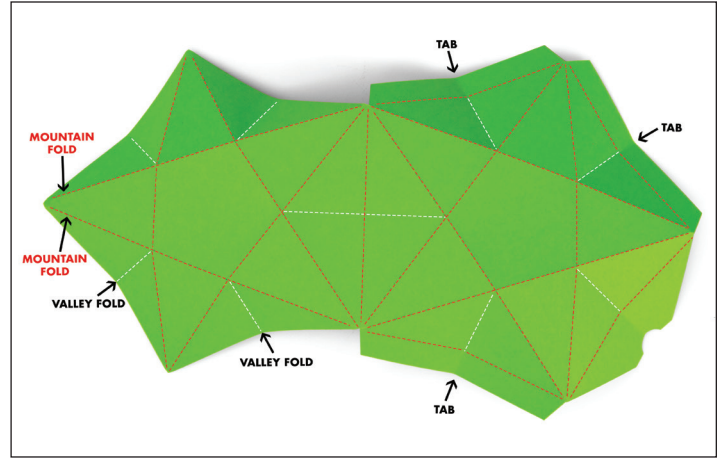

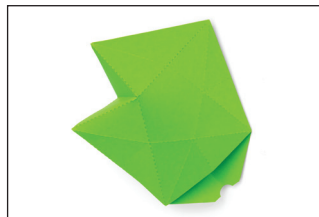

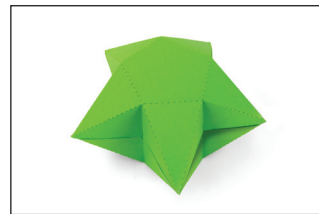

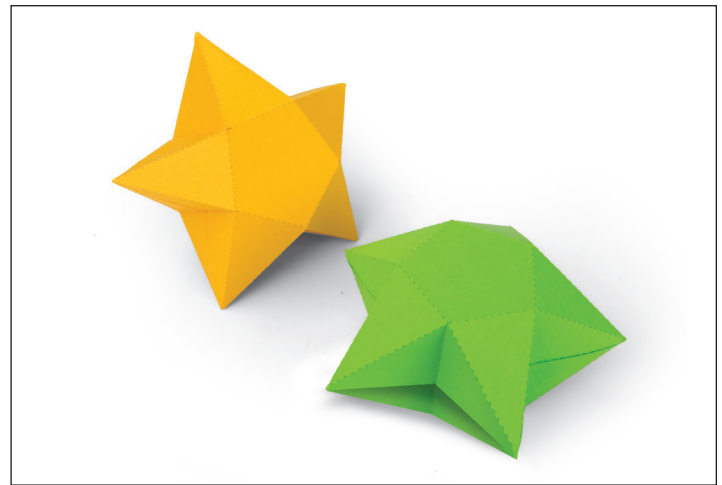

The teacher will die-cut the materials for student use prior to the lesson.

1. Die-cut the box out of colored paper (Figure A).
2. Fold on all of the perforations. The long lines are mountain folds, and the short lines are valley folds (Figure B).
3. Place adhesive on the tabs around the perimeter of one half of the design (Figures B), and fold the box in half, using the sticky tabs to hold it closed (Figure C). It is easiest to decorate the box while it is flat if you want to add student designs to it.
4. Once the adhesive has set or dried, push in on all of the valley folds to create the three-dimensional star design (Figures D, E & F).
5. The side, with the half-circle notch cut out, is where you open the box. When your items are stored inside, fold this opening closed along the perforations (Figures E & G).
