

Puppet, Finger Puppet Panda

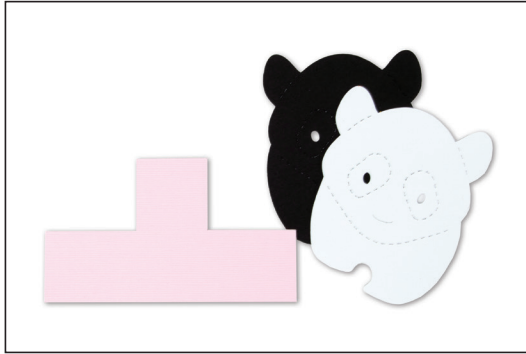

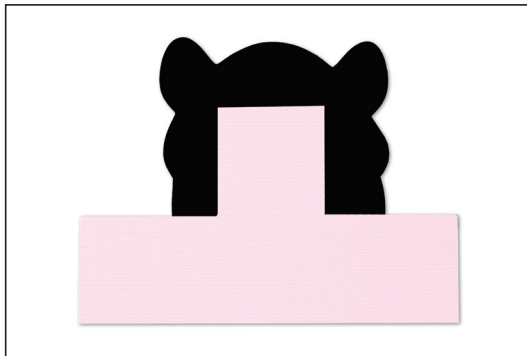

The teacher will die-cut the materials for student use prior to the lesson.

1. Die-cut the puppet pieces from colored paper (Figure A).
2. Using the perforation as a guide, trim the panda details and layer on top of the panda shape (Figure B). The panda nose can be colored with a dark marker.
3. Attach the panda to the finger puppet base (Figure C). Curl the ends around, overlap and secure them together with adhesive, tape or a stapler (Figure D).
4. Students need to slide only a couple of fingers into the opening in order to play with their finger puppets.
5. The teacher can die-cut multiple bases and allow students to create more finger puppets of their own design.
