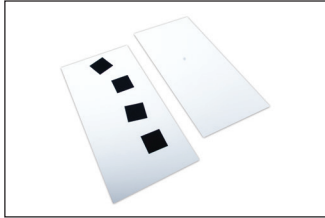

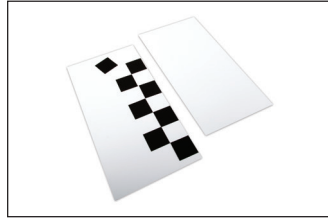

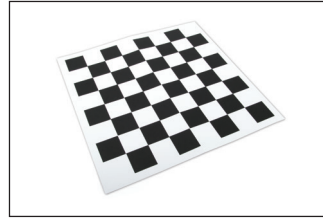

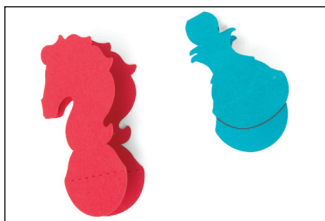

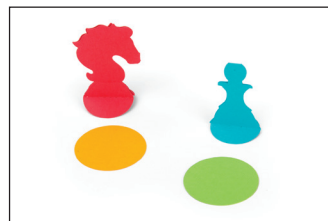

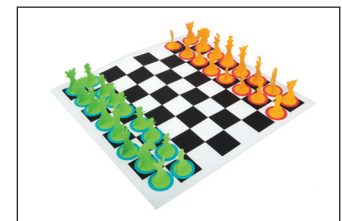

The teacher will die-cut the materials for student use prior to the lesson.

### CREATE THE CHESS BOARD

1. Die-cut 32 black squares.
2. Cut two white cardstock or poster board sheets to 6 1/2" x 13" (Figure A).
3. Tape the two sheets together to form a 13" square that can be folded in half for easy storage (Figure B).
4. Leaving a 1/2" border around the outside edges, attach the black squares in a checkerboard pattern (Figure C).

### CREATE THE CHESS PIECES

1. Die-cut the Chess Pieces from colored paper or cardstock, choosing a different color for each side and contrasting colors for the bases (Figure D).
2. Fold each Chess Piece in half (they are all symmetrical). The knight folds along the side, and the other pieces fold along the top (Figure E).
3. Fold each Chess Piece along the perforations (Figure F), and add adhesive to the bottoms in order to attach them to the circle bases (Figure G).
4. Position the Chess Pieces on the board (Figure H), and let the games begin!
